

MAP AND CATERING FACILITIES

Franklin Wilkins Building (Kings College Waterloo Campus)

The course will be held in the Franklin Wilkins Building (Kings College Waterloo Campus), 150 Stamford Street, London SE1 9NH.

Please note you will need to sign in for security purposes as you enter the building and also when you come into the room where the lecture is being held. Sorry about that but security need their own record of you being in the building and we need it for our attendance sheet at the start of the lecture.

By Underground

Waterloo is the nearest tube. Although Embankment, Westminster and Charing Cross are within walking distance.

By Bus

Details of bus services can also be found on the Transport for London website at www.tfl.gov.uk/buses. Local buses which serve the locality are 1, 4, 26, 59, 68, 76, 77, 168, 171, 176, 188, 211, 243, 341, 381, 501, 505, 507 and 521. RV1.

By Rail

Waterloo and Waterloo East station are a 5 min walk away. Charing Cross is a 15 min walk away. Please see www.nationalrail.co.uk for details of route planning and train times.

By Car

Please note that there is extremely limited local parking facilities and driving is not recommended. Congestion charges apply until 6.30pm on weekdays if applicable for those coming by car.

Walking directions from Waterloo Station

Leave Waterloo Station / Underground via the "Waterloo Road" exit. Cross Waterloo Road and turn left, going towards the IMAX cinema roundabout and Waterloo Bridge. This will take you past St John's Church. When you reach the IMAX roundabout, take the right-hand turn into Stamford Street. This will take you past the King's College London James Clerk Maxwell Building, which is on the corner. The Franklin-Wilkins Building is number 150, Stamford Street – it is a large yellowish orange building on the left-hand side as you walk down Stamford Street.

Catering Facilities

Day Courses

Whilst refreshments will be served in the morning break and afternoon, lunch is not included. There are a number of local shops near Waterloo station. On Stamford street there is Fratelli, a deli/café. Down the Cut (by the New Vic theatre) there is a lovely Tapas bar and a pub serving Thai food. On Belevedere Road, which is a 10 min walk from the venue (by the Millennium wheel) there is Yo Sushi, Starbucks, Neds Noodles and the Bagel Factory to name but a few of the various eateries. Of course there is Waterloo station which has a Costa coffee, a Starbucks and McDonalds. Finally, there are a number of restaurants and a sandwich shop on Upper Ground and especially in Gabriel's Wharf and others by the Royal Festival Hall such as Giraffe.
