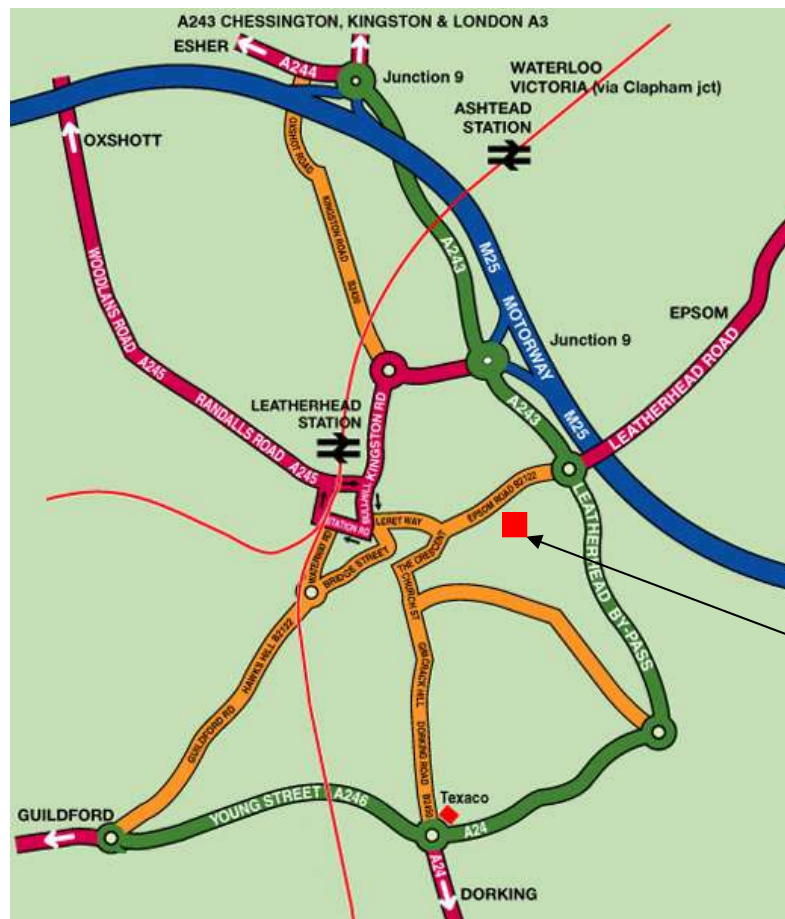


MAP AND CATERING FACILITIES

Leatherhead Hospital



The course will be held in the Physiotherapy Dept, Leatherhead Hospital, Poplar Road (at the end of St John's Road), Leatherhead, KT22 8SD



Leatherhead Hospital

From M25 Junc 9 (Coming from a clockwise direction)

Exit the M25 at Junction 9 (signed Leatherhead A243, Dorking (A24)). At the roundabout at the end of the slip road, take the first exit onto the A243 (Leatherhead Bypass Road). At the Knoll roundabout, take the third exit onto the B2122 (Epsom Road). Turn into the second road on the left, Fortyfoot Road, then take the first on the right into Polar Road. The hospital is found on Poplar Road at the junction with Leach Grove.

From M25 Junc 9 (Coming from Anti Clockwise)

Exit the motorway, then at the first roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the A243 towards Epsom (A24) and Leatherhead Town Centre. Continue over the next roundabout continuing towards Leatherhead Town Centre. At the next roundabout, The Knoll Roundabout, take the third exit onto the B2122 (Epsom Road). Turn into the second road on the left, Fortyfoot Road, then take the first on the right into Polar Road. The hospital is found on Poplar Road at the junction with Leach Grove.

From M3

At Junction 2 on the M3, turn onto the M25, and head anticlockwise around the M25 towards Gatwick. Turn off the M25 at Junction 9 (signed Leatherhead A243, Dorking (A24) and follow anticlockwise signs above.

From M4

At Junction 4B, turn onto the M25 and head anticlockwise around the M25 towards Gatwick. Turn off the M25 at Junction 9 (signed Leatherhead A243, Dorking (A24) and follow anticlockwise signs above.

Parking

Car parking is free in the hospital and on local streets.

By Train

Nearest mainline BR station is Leatherhead which is 1 mile away. Check the UK routes and timetables on www.nationalrail.co.uk or call 0845 7484950. Local taxi numbers are Leatherhead cars on 01372 370307 or Ashted cars on 01372 271271.
