

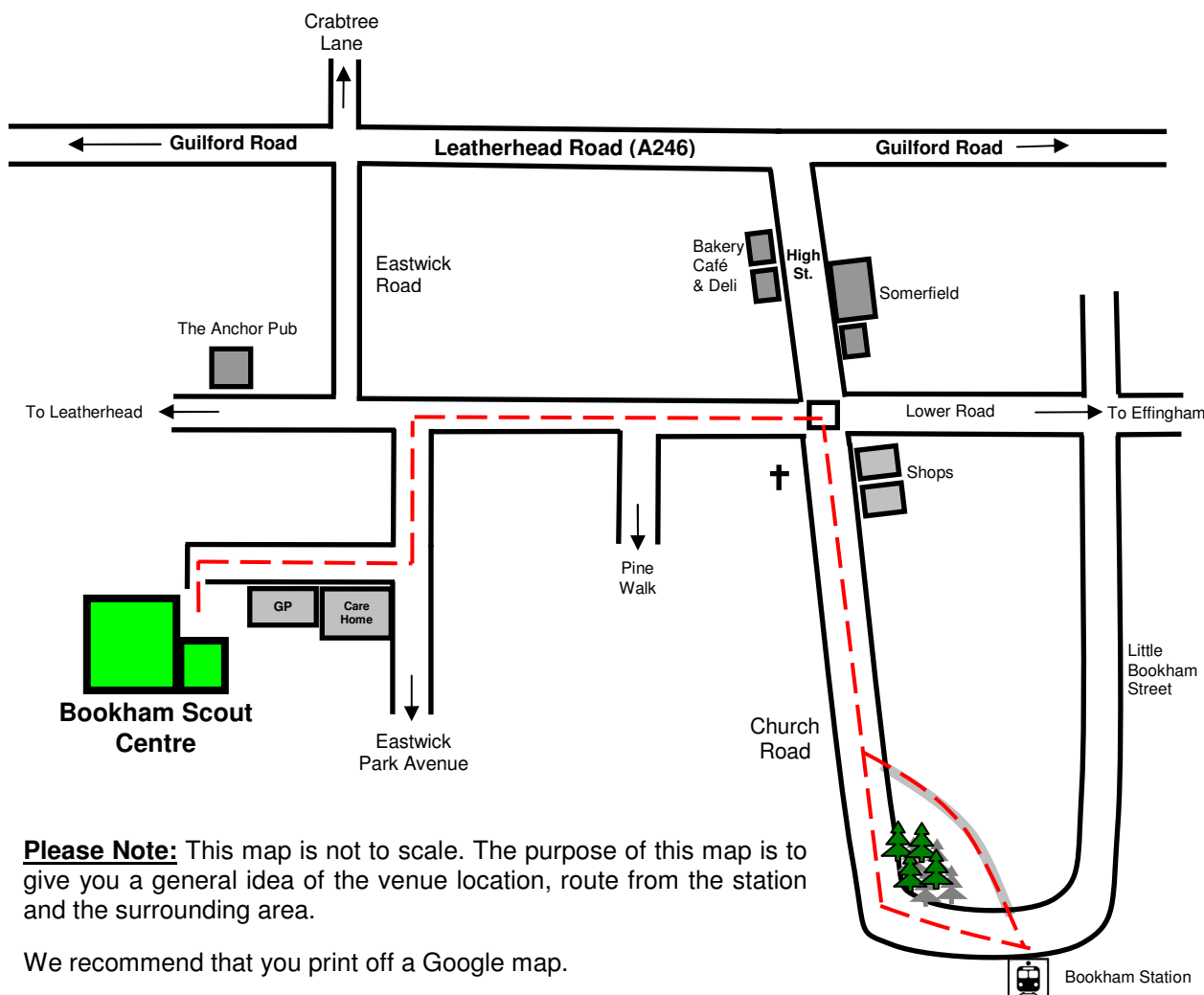
# MAP AND CATERING FACILITIES

## Bookham Scouting Centre



The course will be held in the Bookham Scouting Centre, Eastwick Park Avenue, Bookham, Leatherhead, Surrey KT23 3NA. Please see the notes at the end of the map which give you directions to the course location when you arrive at the venue.

If no map is supplied, this is because we have been unable to find one we can legally reproduce. Whether one is supplied or not we recommend you have an alternative map. We recommended you print off a Google map which can be accessed by entering the venue postcode into Google maps ([www.google.co.uk/maps](http://www.google.co.uk/maps)). It is recommended you print off some travel directions using the postcode you are setting out from as a start point. The AA website ([www.theaa.com](http://www.theaa.com)) also has a good route planner.



**Please Note:** This map is not to scale. The purpose of this map is to give you a general idea of the venue location, route from the station and the surrounding area.

We recommend that you print off a Google map.

### By Car:

#### **From Leatherhead**

Follow signs for Leatherhead Leisure Centre / Leatherhead Football Club, drive past the centre and under the bridge. At the mini roundabout, turn right (signposted Cobham A245) at Zen Garden on the corner. Drive 1/4 mile and at the mini roundabout turn left (signposted Bookham). You will now be on Lower Road. Drive 1.5 miles (going over 1 roundabout) until you see the Anchor pub on your left. Take the next right into Eastwick Park Avenue (signposted Scouting Centre) and turn immediately right going past the care home, and GP's. At the end of the road, turn left. Drive through the black gates into the Scouting Centre.

#### **Car Parking**

There is an onsite parking facility, although spaces are limited. There is street parking nearby, and a pay and display car park can be found just off Church Road.

## **By Train**

Train times and routes can be obtained from National Rail enquiries on 0845 7484950 or [www.nationalrail.co.uk](http://www.nationalrail.co.uk). See the bus details below for local services.

The nearest train station is Bookham Railway Station, which is a 25 minute walk from the venue. On exiting the Station, walk across the park, as shown on map (the road route doesn't have a pavement) until it joins the main road (Lower Road) at the square roundabout. Turn left onto Lower Road and continue along this road, turning left onto Eastwick Park Avenue (signposted scouting centre). Then take the immediate right, walking past the care home and the GP's, then turn left. Continue through the black gates to the centre.

Bookham railway station does have an on site taxi rank / cab office should you require. Alternatively, Bookham Taxis are available on 01372 800088 and charge around £7-£8 from Leatherhead to the venue. See the bus details below for local services and further travel information.

## **By Bus**

The best place to find details of bus services is [www.transportdirect.info](http://www.transportdirect.info) (you can enter the details of where you are coming from and enter the venue postcode as the destination). A regular bus service runs from Great Bookham (1 min from Station) to Lower Road (4 mins from Venue).

## **Further Travel Information**

### **Travelling from Gatwick?**

By train is £15 return to Dorking, or alternatively by taxi is £35 to the venue

### **Travelling from London?**

The train journey from Victoria to Leatherhead is approximately 40 minutes

### **Travelling from Luton?**

By train is approximately £18 to Leatherhead station

## **Catering Facilities**

### **Day Courses**

Whilst refreshments will be provided, lunch is not included. The venue does have a kitchen facility, including a fridge and a microwave, so food could be bought and heated up. There are a number of shops nearby (within 5 mins) including a Pub, Bakery, Deli and a local Supermarket (open Monday to Sunday).

For the Supermarket (Somerfield), exit through the main entrance of the centre and turn right. Continue to the end of the road until turning left onto Eastwick Park Avenue, and then right onto Lower Road. Continue along Lower Road until reaching the square roundabout ahead, and turn left onto the High Street. Somerfield is then found on the right side of the road.

The High Street also has a bakery, deli and café which can all be found near Somerfield.

## **Notes for finding the department when you have arrived at the venue**

Having passed the GPs on the left, turn left at the basketball court and continue through the black gates where there will be available parking outside the venue. Entering through the main entrance, at the front the main hall is found straight on through the double doors ahead. The smaller meeting room is found on your immediate right having entered through the main entrance, just after the disabled toilets.

## **Accommodation**

If you have any accommodation requirements during the course, please see the below variety of nearby hotels and Bed & Breakfasts and what previous participants thought of them.

### **Preston Cross Hotel**

**Price:** Approx £60 - £95 for bed and breakfast

**Locality:** Approx 20 min walk or 5 min drive to venue

**Food:** Approx £10 - £15 for a main course, Frankie an Benny's next door, Nepalese restaurant okay

**Internet:** Wi-Fi available in some rooms, but with a small charge (see website)

**Comments:** Can get noisy if there is a wedding party booked but a nice hotel with clean rooms

### **Hilton Hotel (Cobham)**

**Price:** Approx £108 bed and breakfast

**Locality:** Approx 15-20 min drive to venue

**Internet:** Ensure you ask for internet connection when you book

**Comments:** The Hotel has a small gym, pool, jacuzzi, sauna, Hilton standard

### **Bookham Grange Hotel**

**Price:** Approx £45-£60 for bed and breakfast

**Locality:** Approx 20 min walk from venue

**Food:** Food is the usual pub grub. "Classic" old style, lace-table-cloth decor

**Internet:** Free internet

**Comments:** Can have music but finishes at 11pm on weekends. English hotel in the quiet countryside with surrounding woods but can have a busy bar at weekends

### **Horsley Park Hotel**

**Price:** Approx £89 (bed only)

**Food:** Good but small portions and pricey

**Internet:** Free internet

**Comments:** Posh and has nice grounds with running tracks, a quiet secluded area

### **Ramada Jarvis (Guildford)**

**Price:** Approx £85 per night, bed and breakfast

**Locality:** Approx 4 miles away from the venue

**Internet:** The internet costs £1.00 for 20 minutes usage

**Comments:** Nice room, bar, breakfast can be slow if the hotel is busy but the bar does nice food

### **Travelodge (Leatherhead)**

**Price:** Approx £40-£65, it's cheaper if booked earlier

**Locality:** Approx 5 min drive (£7 taxi) or 20 min walk to the venue

**Food:** Penny Black pub – decent food and sport / beer, Ashish Tandori does great food!

**Internet:** Wi-Fi is available but costs £5 - £20 depending on the usage

**Comments:** Good location, no air con, train at 8.23am to Bookham (£3.60). No onsite parking but free parking 5-10 mins walk away. Rooms a good size, Double rooms have a double bed and sofa bed so sharing is an option. Can get a little noisy depending on which room and can be noisy in the corridor

### **YHA (Holmbury St Mary)**

**Price:** Approx £15-16 per night for members (pay extra for a towel)

**Locality:** Approx 8 miles away (narrow lanes), approx 50 min cycle (hilly) from venue

**Food:** There is food but it also has a self catering kitchen

**Comments:** Has parking and rooms are basic with 2 bunks (4 people). A lounge for relaxing in but it can be a little noisy sometimes

### **YHA (Tanners Hatch)**

**Price:** Approx £15 a night for members (extra for towel)

**Locality:** Approx 3-4 miles away (50 min walk or 10 min drive to venue)

**Food:** Self catering only

**Comments:** Small but very nice and quiet with 4 to a room. Toilets and showers are outside but they are good. No parking nearby (approx 10 min walk), but you are able to drop off bags

### **Alder Bed and Breakfast**

**Price:** Approx £30 per day

**Locality:** Approx 15 mins walk from the venue

**Food:** Refreshments tray in room and choice of full English or continental breakfast

**Internet:** Free Wi-Fi

**Comments:** Clean and tidy, office to catch up on work. Good breakfast and a cross trainer to burn it off!
