

## MAP AND CATERING FACILITIES

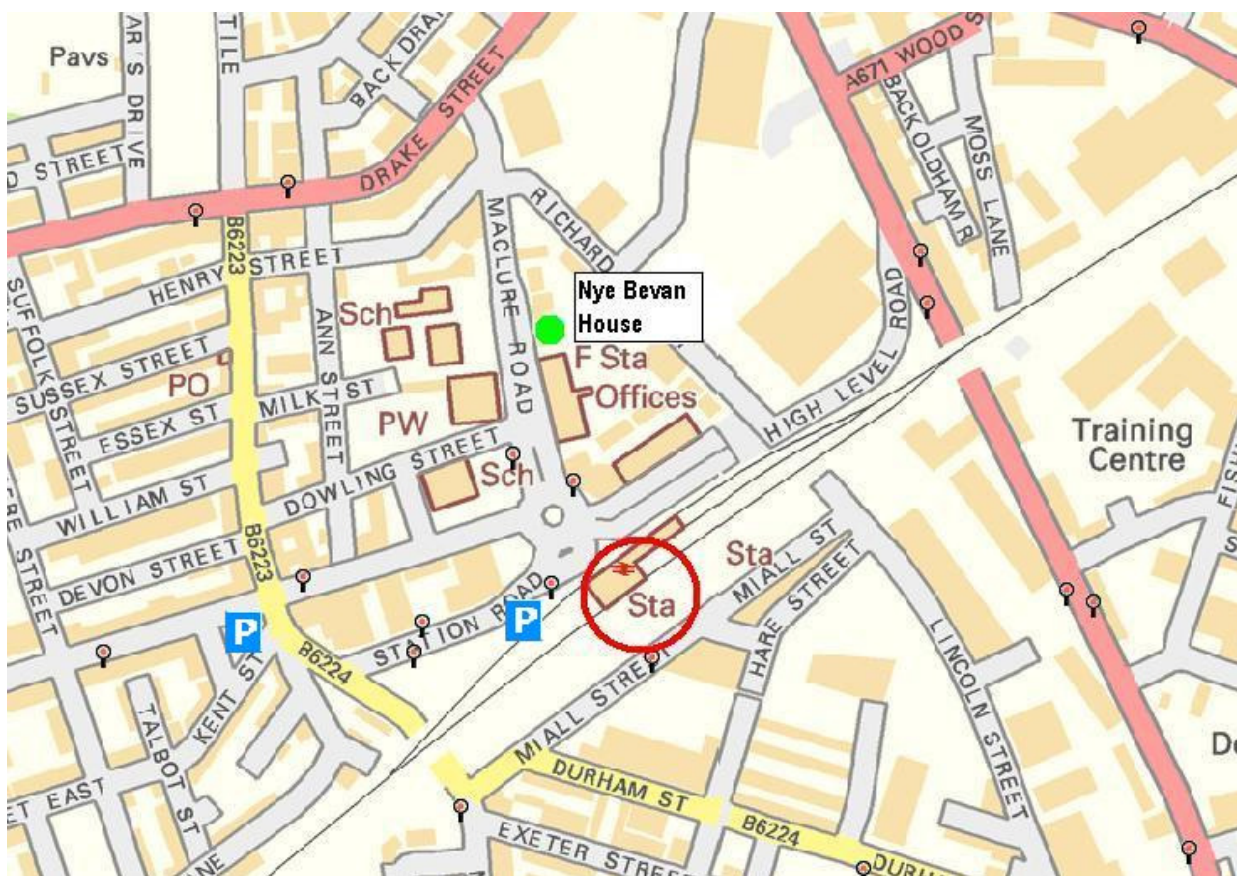
### Nye Bevan House



The course will be held in the Physiotherapy Department, Nye Bevan House, Maclure Road, Rochdale, Lancashire, OL11 1DN. Please see the notes at the end of the map which gives you directions to the course location when you arrive at the venue.

If you are going to be late for a course or unable to attend please call the emergency contact number you will be given in your pre course confirmation information and give the person running the day as much notice as possible. Many thanks

If no map is supplied, this is because we have been unable to find one we can legally reproduce. Whether one is supplied or not we recommend you have an alternative map. We recommended you print off a Google map which can be accessed by entering the venue postcode into Google maps ([www.google.co.uk/maps](http://www.google.co.uk/maps)). It is recommended you print off some travel directions using the postcode you are setting out from as a start point. The AA website ([www.theaa.com](http://www.theaa.com)) also has a good route planner.



### **By Car:**

Rochdale is North East of Manchester and is situated close to the M66, M62 and the A627 motorways.

If coming from the **Manchester** region, the ideal route requires you to merge onto the M62. After 0.3 miles take the A627 exit at junction 20 towards Rochdale/Oldham. Then take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit at the roundabout onto the A627 towards Rochdale. Turn left at Edinburgh Way where you will see signs for Rochdale/A66/A58. At the next roundabout take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit onto Manchester Road, and then turn right after 0.8 miles onto Drake St. Finally, after 0.4 miles turn right onto Maclure Road where the venue is on your left hand side opposite the school.

If coming from the **Leeds** area, the M62 is also the efficient route of travel. If you're taking the M621 to join the M62, then take the exit toward M62 and after 24 miles, keep right at the fork whilst following the signs for Manchester/M62. At junction 21 you should exit toward the A640 and take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit from the roundabout, going straight over the 4 roundabouts that follow and continuing straight onto the A664. After half a mile turn right onto Oldham Road and follow for 1 mile, then turning left at Milnrow Road. Then take the 1<sup>st</sup> left onto Drake Street and the following 1<sup>st</sup> left onto Maclure Road where the venue is on your left hand side, opposite the school.

### **Car Parking**

For evening workshops, the patient parking facility is available and is free of charge and can be found across the road from the centre. There are also two nearby parking facilities situated on Kent Street and Station Road. Rochdale Station Car Park is situated by Rochdale Rail Station on Station Road and is an on street parking area outside the station front.

### **By Rail**

The nearest train station is **Rochdale Rail Station** which is just a 2 minute walk away from the venue. On exiting the station, head North West towards the roundabout and continue straight over the roundabout onto Maclure Road. Continue walking up Maclure Road, where St. John The Baptist RC Church will be on the left and Nye Bevan House on the right side of the road, opposite the school.

## **Catering Facilities**

### **Day Courses**

Hot and cold refreshments will be served during the morning and afternoon breaks in the course, however lunch is not included. The venue does have an on site Café which opens at 9am and closes at 4pm. There is a nearby shop next door to the hospital.

### **Evening Workshop**

Hot and cold refreshments will be served during the 10 minute break in the middle of the workshop. There is a nearby shop next door to the hospital.

## **Notes for finding the course location when you have arrived at the venue**

On arrival through the main entrance, there is a reception area where a member of staff will be present (includes Tuesday evenings). They will provide you with directions to the Physiotherapy Department, where the course or workshop is taking place.
