

# MAP AND CATERING FACILITIES

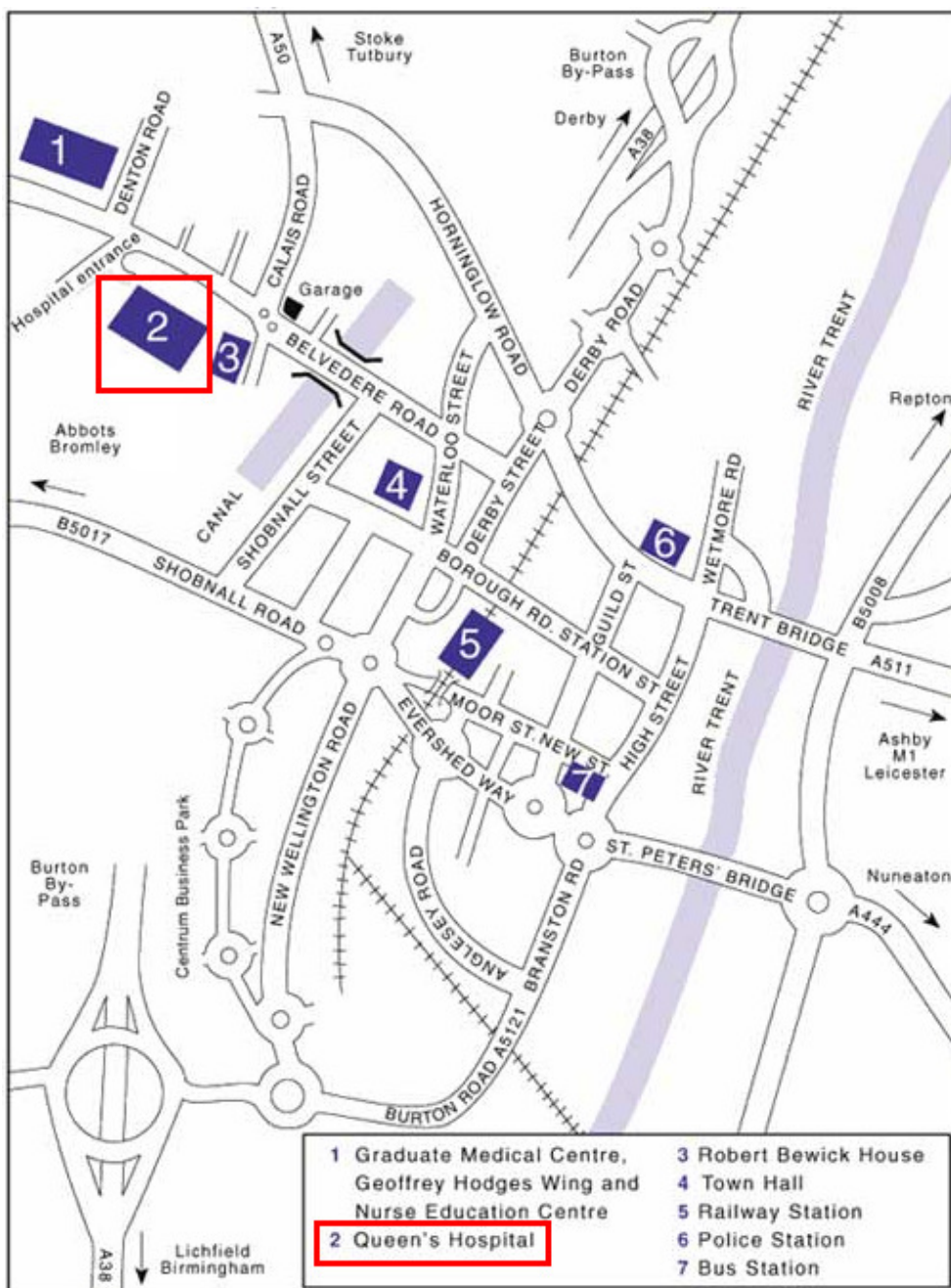
## Queen's Hospital



The course will be held in the Physiotherapy Department of Queen's Hospital, Belvedere Road, Burton upon Trent, Staffordshire DE13 0RB. Please see the notes at the end of the map which give you directions to the course location when you arrive at the venue.

If no map is supplied, this is because we have been unable to find one we can legally reproduce. Whether one is supplied or not we recommend you have an alternative map. We recommended you print off a Google map which can be accessed by entering the venue postcode into Google maps ([www.google.co.uk/maps](http://www.google.co.uk/maps)). It is recommended you print off some travel directions using the postcode you are setting out from as a start point. The AA website ([www.theaa.com](http://www.theaa.com)) also has a good route planner.

## **By Car:**

Burton-on-Trent is located 35 miles north east of Birmingham, 12 miles south west of Derby.

### **From Derby**

Continue along the A38 for 8 miles, following the exits for Derby Road (A5121). At the roundabout, take the fourth exit onto Horninglow Road (A511) and continue for 1 mile. Turn left onto Calais Road, then right onto Charnwood Road. Bear left onto Norton Road, then right at Belvedere Road and continue until reaching the hospital.

### **From Tamworth**

Along the A5, take the exits for the A38. Stay on the A38 for 10.5 miles, and take the slip road, then the third exit at the roundabout for the A5121. Then take the first exit onto Parkway, and continue for half a mile. Take the third exit for Wellington Road, then the second exit for Wellington Street and bear left onto Waterloo Street. Turn left onto Dallow Street and continue on Belvedere Road until reaching the hospital.

### **From Loughborough**

Coming along the A50, continue for 12 miles and exit on the slip road. At the roundabout, take the second exit and bear left onto Burton Road. Continue on the A38 for 1.5 miles and exit onto Derby Road. Turn left onto Calais Road, then right onto Charnwood Road. Bear left onto Norton Road, then right at Belvedere Road and continue until reaching the hospital.

### **From Stafford**

Coming along the M6, continue onto the M6 Toll and continue again for 11 miles. Bear left onto the Slip Road, and continue on the A38 for 10 miles and exit onto the Slip Road. Take the third exit for Wellington Road, then the second exit for Wellington Street and bear left onto Waterloo Street. Turn left onto Dallow Street and continue on Belvedere Road until reaching the hospital.

## **Car Parking**

Parking is limited at the hospital, and charges do apply. Parking for 7 hours or more costs £5.00, and you can pay upon leaving the car park. It is advisable to use public transport whenever possible. There is also Pay-and-Display parking located near the train station.

## **By Train**

The nearest railway station is Burton-on-Trent which is 1 mile away, about a 20 minute walk. Buses run regularly to and from the hospital, railway station and the town centre, which is 2 miles away.

A local taxi service is Station Taxis – 01283 532 000, or alternatively there is Pauls Cars nearby who can be contacted on: 01283 500600.

## **By Bus**

The following bus routes regularly run between Burton Town Centre, the Railway Station and the Hospital. These routes are 13, 14, 14A, 15, 19 and 19A.

## **Catering Facilities**

### **Day Courses**

Whilst refreshments will be provided, lunch is not included. We suggest that you either bring a packed lunch with you, or use the restaurant and shop facilities that can be found in the Main Hospital, on the ground and first floor.

**The Cooper Restaurant** (first floor) is open Monday to Sunday from 7.30am - 10.30am, midday - 2pm, and from 4pm - 7.30pm. **The Coffee Lounge** (found next to the Restaurant) is open from 11am - 4pm, Monday to Friday, selling a range of sandwiches, snacks and hot and cold drinks. The **Hospital Shop** (ground floor) is open from 8am - 8pm Monday to Friday, and 9am - 8pm at weekends.
