

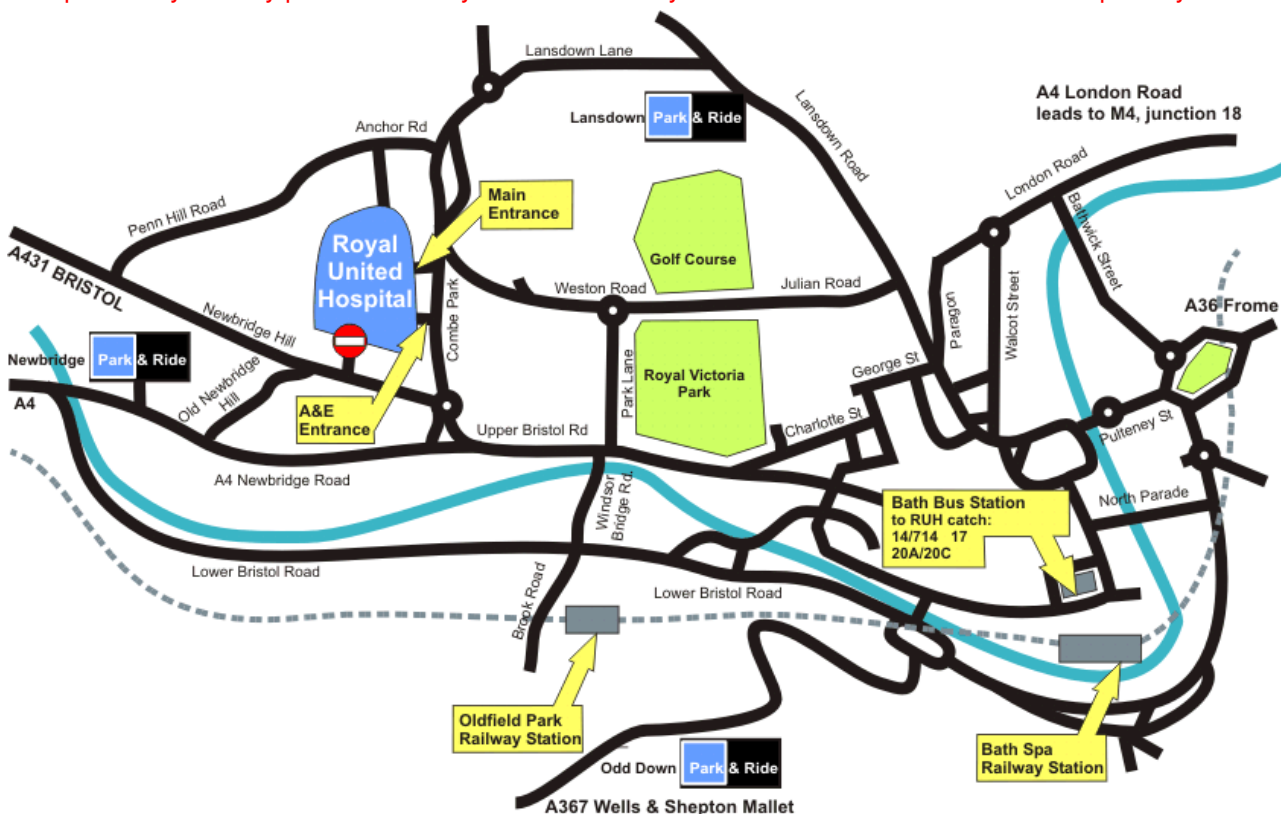
MAP AND CATERING FACILITIES

Royal United Hospital, Bath

The course will be held in the Physiotherapy Department, Royal United Hospital, Combe Park, Bath BA1 3NG. Please see the notes at the end of the map which give you directions to the course location when you arrive at the venue.

If no map is supplied, this is because we have been unable to find one we can legally reproduce. Whether one is supplied or not we recommend you have an alternative map. We recommended you print off a Google map which can be accessed by entering the venue postcode into Google maps (www.google.co.uk/maps). It is recommended you print off some travel directions using the postcode you are setting out from as a start point. The AA website (www.theaa.com) also has a good route planner.

The Physiotherapy Department is situated on the ground floor of RUH North (see map of site attached). It is a single storey building, is located to the right of the main hospital entrance and has its own, clearly marked entrance. Any local taxi driver will know the RUH and delegates should be asked to be dropped outside the main entrance. There are also buses from the railway station that come straight into the RUH grounds and stop outside the main entrance. The car parking is pay on exit system. The daily parking rate is £6.30. **It is cheaper to buy a 5 day pass for £10 if you are on a 2 day course which then works out to £5 per day.**



By Car:

If you are approaching from the west, north or east, take Bath exit 18 from the M4 motorway. After approximately 2-3 miles, you come to a roundabout where you turn right on to the A420. Take the first turning left and after approx. 3 miles, at a T-junction on a nasty bend on a hill, turn left. After approx. 1 mile, you will see Bath race course on your right. Just after a pub called the Blathwayte Arms on your right, take a little turning on the right signposted Weston. This is a narrow road, down a steep hill. At the bottom of the hill, turn left at a mini roundabout which takes you into Weston village. Keep going on this road and you will see the RUH on your right.

Car parking is available on site and is charged at £6.30 for up to 8 hours although **if you are at the hospital for more than 1 day then it is better value to buy a 5 day pass for £10. Please bring change.** Pay machines are located by the main entrance or by the orange car park.

By Train

The nearest station is Bath Spa railway station which is 2 miles away (see the map above). Taxis are available outside the station.

Train times and routes can be obtained from National Rail enquiries on 0845 7484950 or www.nationalrail.co.uk. See the bus details below for local services.

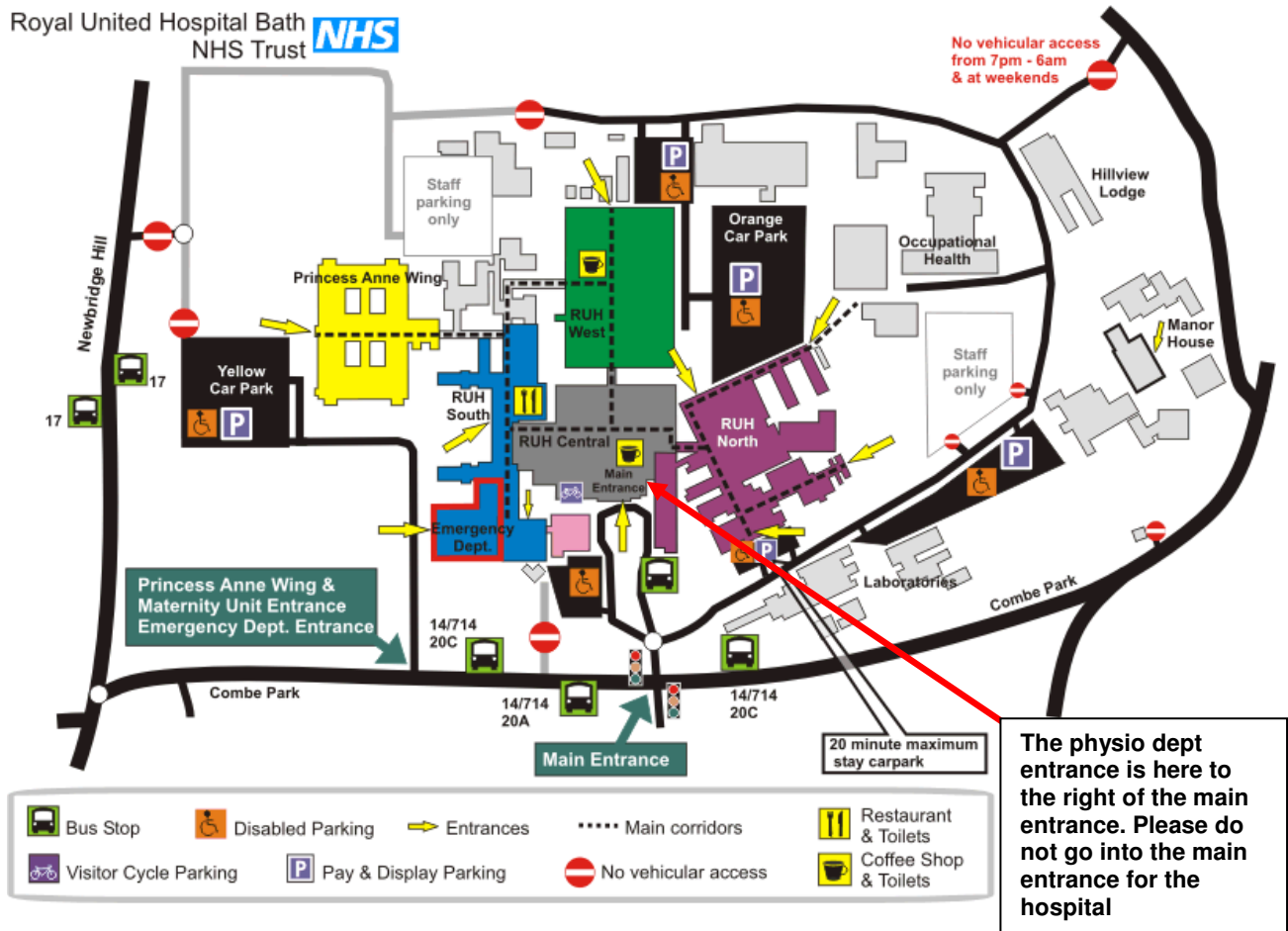
By Bus

The nearest bus station is adjacent to the railway station approx 2 miles from the hospital. You can get to the hospital on a number of bus services.

If you require two buses to reach your destination you may find a through ticket more convenient. Please contact First Group or the railway station about the new 'Plus Bus' ticket that has been launched. You can get more info at www.plusbus.info. To purchase your 'Through' bus and train ticket ring 08457 000125 (8am-8pm, Mondays to Friday, 9am-5pm, Saturdays and Sundays).

The best place to find details of bus services is www.transportdirect.info (you can enter the details of where you are coming from and enter the venue postcode as the destination).

Notes for finding the course location when you have arrived at the venue

From any of the pay and display car parks on site, make your way towards the main entrance of the hospital. When you are facing the main entrance, you should see the entrance of the Physiotherapy Department on your right hand side, recessed back from the main entrance (see map above). You DO NOT need to use the main entrance to the hospital. The course will be held in the Physiotherapy Department. Additionally, there may be yellow 'PHYSIOUK' signs to guide you towards the department.
