

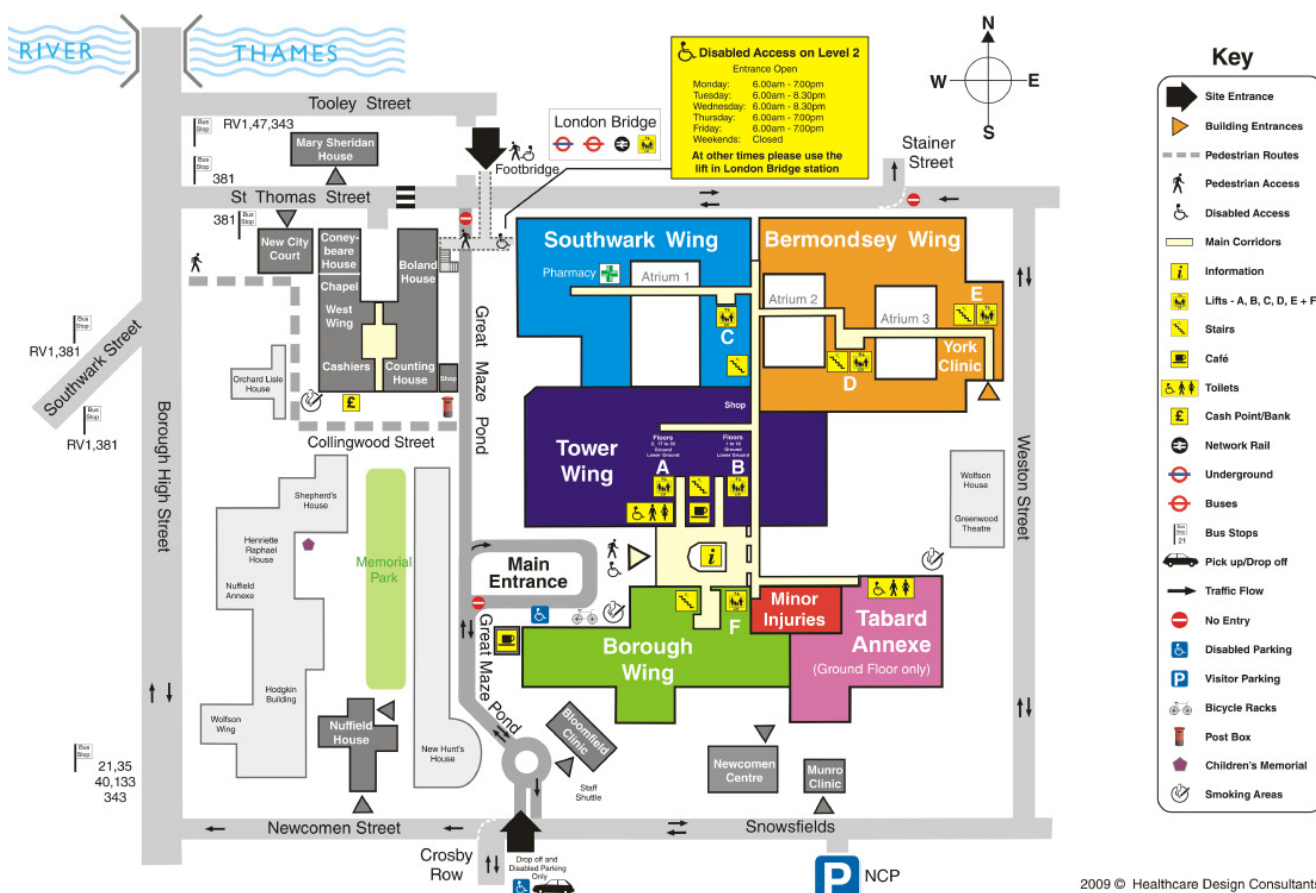
# MAP AND CATERING FACILITIES

## Guy's Hospital



The course will be held in the Physiotherapy Department, Guy's Hospital, Ground Floor, Southwark Wing, Great Maze Pond, London, SE1 9RT. Please see the notes at the end of the map which give you directions to the course location when you arrive at the venue.

Although there is the map that we have supplied below, we recommend you have an alternative map. We advise that you print off a Google map which can be accessed by entering the venue postcode into Google maps ([www.google.co.uk/maps](http://www.google.co.uk/maps)). It is also recommended that you print off some travel directions using the postcode you are setting out from as a start point. The AA website ([www.theaa.com](http://www.theaa.com)) also has a good route planner.

### By Underground

The nearest tube station is London Bridge on the Northern and Jubilee lines (5 minutes' walk), and Monument on the District and Circle lines (15 minutes' walk). ### By Railway

The nearest mainline railway station is London Bridge, which is a 5-10 minute walk away. Train times and routes can be obtained from National Rail enquiries on 0845 7484950 or visit [www.nationalrail.co.uk](http://www.nationalrail.co.uk). See the bus details below for local services.

## **By Bus**

These buses stop at London Bridge, London Bridge station or near Guy's hospital: 17, 21, 35, 40, 43, 47, 48, 133, 141, 149, 343, 381, 521, 701, RV1, C10. For Night Buses stopping at or near the venue, you could use the N21, N35, N47, N133, N343 and N381. Please allow 15-20 minutes to get from the bus stop to where you need to be in the hospital.

## **By Car**

Due to the limited parking available in and around the site, it is strongly recommended by the hospital that visitors should use public transport to travel to the venue. Please note that Guy's Hospital is within the congestion charging zone.

There is no general parking for visitors, although there is limited disabled parking and a drop off facility. There is an NCP car park at the junction of Snowsfield and Kipling Streets, which is about a 2 minute walk from the hospital. However, this car park is often full. Charges are displayed at the entrance.

## **Catering Facilities**

### **Day Lectures**

Whilst refreshments will be served, lunch is not included. The hospital has two canteens which can be found both to the right of the main entrance and also in the Tower Wing of the hospital. This is the closest Physiotherapy Department where the course will be taking place.

There is also an on location shop which can also be found in the Tower Wing

Externally to the hospital, there are two pubs locally (within 5mins) and several cafes/restaurants. The nearest fast food restaurant is McDonalds and there is a Starbucks across the road.

### **Evening Lectures**

Refreshments are not served, but there will be a break in the middle.

## **Notes for finding the course location when you have arrived at the venue**

The main entrance of the building is found on Great Maze Pond which can be accessed by foot via Snowfields and St.Thomas Street. If having arrived via bus on Borough High Street, there is a pedestrian route leading to Great Maze Pond which can be found around the back of New City Court.

The Physiotherapy Department is situated in the Southwark Wing of the hospital, so on entering the main entrance you should walk straight past the information desk to the main corridor and take a left. The physiotherapy department is along there on your right hand side.
